

# **SQUEEZE PAGE BUDDY**

## **The Talking Squeeze Page Creator**

### INSTRUCTIONS

We have created this software to be simple to use and if you follow the Hints and Tips in the software you should have no problem using this software and creating high Converting Talking Squeeze page with little effort.

However, there are a few things you need to know so read carefully.

This software will create 4 squeeze page and one download page for all the squeeze pages you create or you can create a separate download page for each squeeze page

The Software will create 17 HTML pages

You will have the option to use Getresponse Autoresponder, Aweber Autoresponder and all other Autoresponder form codes.

If you're using an autoresponder code other than Getresponse or Aweber you must style your form from your autoresponder form setup to suit the squeeze page you're creating.

# Instruction For Using a Getresponse Form Code

When logged into your Getresponse account click "Create Form" and select the Plain HTML Version

On The right panel select the campaign you're creating the form for.

Your button text won't matter because you'll create your button text in the software.

Leave Custom Thank You Page URL Un checked. You will put your redirect URL in the software

Click To Add "Name" Field

Now near the top of the Form HTML code look for

`<!-- Campaign token -->`

`<input type="hidden" name="campaign_token" value="4zy35" />`

The plain HTML form. Generate raw HTML without CSS or JavaScript.

The Software will ask you if you want to use a Getresponse Form Code. Select YES. and Click Next. In the Space provided Paste in Your "Value". Click Next. Now enter your redirect URL. This can be a Thank you for subscribing page or a special offer.

In the Next Two Steps Select NO To use Aweber and Next for All other Form Codes

# Instruction For Using a Aweber Form Code

When logged into your Aweber account click "Sign Up Forms"  
Then click "Create A Sign Up Form"

You will use the plain form that should already be selected  
Click "Go To Step 2"

In the drop-down menu under "Thank You Page:  
Select "Custom Page"  
Now Enter your Custome URL in the space provided  
Check "Open in a new window"

Save Your Form and Click "Go To Step 3"

Now Select "I will Install My Form"

Click on "Raw HTML Version"



## For Those Comfortable with Raw HTML:

- Easily customizable to fit any scenario.
- Track statistics in your account.

To view the code properly copy and paste it into a notepad file.

Now copy and paste the listname" value="awlist4655503" onto a notepad to use later when you create your squeeze pages

In This Example, the list name value is: awlist4655503

Now copy the FULL redirect" value URL

NOTE: The Redirect value URL is long and all the characters are not showing in the window so you need to drag right when highlighting until you get the full URL Without the quotes.

(Eaiser To View in a Notepad file)

Now copy and paste the FULL redirect" value URL onto a notepad to use later when you create your squeeze pages

The Software will ask you if you want to use an Aweber Form Code.

Select YES. and Click Next. In the Space provided Paste in Your List Name "Value". Click Next. Now enter your redirect URL. This can be a Thank you for subscribing page or a special offer.

If your using Aweber select "NO" To Use Getresponse and Next For All Other Form Codes

## Instruction For Using Other Form Codes

When Creating your Opt-in form in your autoresponder account make the form as plain as possible. Just The Name Field and the Email Field.

The form you create will be shown on your squeeze page so make it fit according to the squeeze page you're creating.

Select NO to use Getresponse and NO to use Aweber. Paste your form code into the space provided and click next.

You Will now have the option to create another squeeze page.  
Select YES or NO

After you've made your selections and created your squeeze pages  
You will be asked if you want to create one download page for all your  
squeeze pages or create a separate download page for an individual squeeze  
page.

If you created different versions of your squeeze pages for one product then  
you only need one download page. If you created different squeeze pages for  
multiple products then create the download pages separately.

After you completed your squeeze pages and download pages click finish.  
Select an empty folder on your computer and save the files to that folder.

The software will open the folder when completed.

You will have 4 Folders.

**Aweber**

**Getresponse**

**Other-Forms**

**Download-Pages**

Don't let this confuse you!

Keep The Getresponse Folder if you used Getresponse as your Autoresponder

Keep The Aweber Folder if you used Aweber as your Autoresponder

Keep The Other-Forms Folder if you used Any other Autoresponder

Keep The Download-Pages Folder

Delete The Folders You Didn't Create

If you created one download page for all squeeze pages then Keep The ALL Download page and delete the rest

If you created your download pages separately then delete the ones you didn't create and keep the ones you did create.

After you finish this process you should have one folder of Squeeze Pages and the download pages for those squeeze pages.

If you created more than one squeeze page then create additional folders on your computer and separate the HTML pages

Example: If you created all the squeeze pages create 4 folders on your computer

One folder for the Guru HTML pages, One folder for the Classic HTML pages, One Folder for the Two Step HTML pages and One Folder for the Video HTML pages.

After you have all the HTML pages separated rename the squeeze page to index.html and rename the download page to something that people won't



easily guess.

Now Create and Name as many folders on your server as you did on your computer and upload the files to your server.

To make this process as easy as possible it is best to have everything you will need ready before you start the squeeze page creation process.

Then all you will need to do is copy and paste the items in the software when prompted.

What you will need:

1: Your Getresponse or Aweber Values  
or your autoresponder form code if you're using another Autoresponder

2: The Background Image URLs that you will be using for your squeeze pages.

If you have the Free Version we have provided you with 4 Images  
You must upload these images to 3rd party image sharing site or your own self-hosted images

If you have the pro version simply click on the link in the software and it will take you to the image gallery.

3: Your Talking Buddy javascript code  
We have provided you with one Talking Buddy Code with the Free Version

If you have the pro version simply click on the link in the software and it will take you to the Talking Buddy Code Page

4: Your product Zip file download URL

5 Your 5 Banners codes for your download page
